Strategies for Tutoring Children

10 am to 12 noon

If you're a tutor for BHITC this free training is for you! Attendees will learn tutoring techniques for working one-on-one with school students. Topics in the session will include:

- How to assess your student's progress
- Managing / redirecting poor behavior.
- Accessing and using educational resources that are appropriate for your student.

Refugee Mentor Training

9 am to 1 pm

This training is a pre-requisite for joining a BHITC volunteer mentoring team be-friending a newly arriving refugee family. Participants will gain an understanding of the resettlement process in Cleveland, including small group discussions of mentor expectations, resources and how to handle various situations when working across cultures. This session also includes a Virtus training on protecting vulnerable populations from predators.

Teaching English: A training for new ESL Teachers

1 to 3:30 pm

This session offers practical tips and techniques for helping someone begin to learn the English language. BHITC ESL ministries need additional volunteer teachers, and those considering serving as a volunteer refugee mentor will also benefit from this session.

Going Cross Cultural: Refugee Ministry 101

1 to 3:30 pm

Ministry across barriers of culture, language and faith can be a blessing and a challenge. Come learn what it takes to serve well in this work. This session is appropriate for anyone wanting to know more about refugees and other cultures. It is highly recommended for any volunteer working with refugees or immigrants.

This session focuses on strategies for protecting children and ministries from child predators. All volunteers working with children and refugees are required to attend a Virtus training.
